

SUDATEL DELIVERS SIGNIFICANT Q3 2025 IMPROVEMENT

GROUP REVENUES UP 16% YEAR-ON-YEAR; YTD NET PROFIT EXCEEDS USD 71 MILLION

Sudatel Telecom Group (STG) announces its financial results for the nine months ended 30 September 2025, demonstrating a strong turnaround in performance despite persistent challenges in its largest market, Sudan – where the ongoing war wages, since April 2023.

Group operating revenue reached **USD 327.9 million**, compared with **USD 282.0 million** in the same period of 2024. **Net profit rose to USD 71 million**, versus a **Net loss of USD 23 million** reported for the first nine months of 2024.

“We kept Sudan connected when it mattered most — and that resilience is now translating into performance,” *Magdi Taha, Chief Executive Officer said.*

“We are determined to build on this momentum, and create sustainable value for all our stakeholders, across all our operations” he added.

SUDAN: STRONG RECOVERY AND NETWORK RESILIENCE

Year-to-date revenue in Sudan reached **USD 245.2 million**, a **26.4% increase** versus the same period in 2024. Sudan operations generated **USD 87 million** in net profit, a 10-fold increase compared with a **USD 8.7 million loss** last year.

This reflects:

- Further recovery of customer activity across Q3.
- Implementation of selective pricing actions.
- Restoration of network sites, as teams regained safe access to facilities.

Sudatel’s investment in disaster recovery and network redundancy, supported by its ownership of the national terrestrial backbone in Sudan, enabled superior uptime throughout this wartime crisis. Through interconnection support and shared infrastructure, Sudatel has helped sustain resilience across Sudan’s telecom ecosystem, ensuring continuity of vital services, not just for its MNO “Sudani,” but for all telecom operators. This has ultimately provided critical connectivity and safety to the general public.

During Q3 2025 the company continued to reinforce its presence in priority urban localities, aligned with population and economic activity shifts.

STG recognizes that connectivity has been a humanitarian lifeline, supporting families, education, livelihoods, and essential services — forming a core pillar of its corporate ESG mandate.

WEST AFRICA: NAVIGATING CHALLENGES, POSITIONED FOR UPSIDE

Senegal

The operation in Senegal remains challenging, however, some political and regulatory changes are in progress that may provide a measure of relief from the high license and spectrum costs.

The aggressive nature of competition in the mobile services space has resulted in the distortion of pricing across the telecom sector. This has continuously reduced the overall value of the telecom sector over the past two years. On a year-to-Date (YTD) basis, Expresso Telecom (senegal) generated revenues of \$42.3m compared with \$48.9m last year.

In both West African operations, management efforts are focused on broadenign the customer base and performing necessary pricing actions to raise the revenue and EBITDA. This is being pursued in concert with enhancing the network coverage and capacity through additional investment.

Mauritania

In Chinguitel the YTD revenue: USD 31.8M (2024: USD 30.8M), has started to show improvement

This is supported by targeted commercial initiatives and network enhancement.

Across both (Mauritania and Senegal) markets, focus remains on:

- Customer base expansion.
- Pricing and portfolio optimization.
- Revenue and EBITDA improvement.
- Capacity improvement and coverage expansion in alignment with demand.
